- Part 2: 7.30 to 9 pm: evening talk - presentation about 501: addressing Auckland climate conditions, incidence on plant health and food quality.

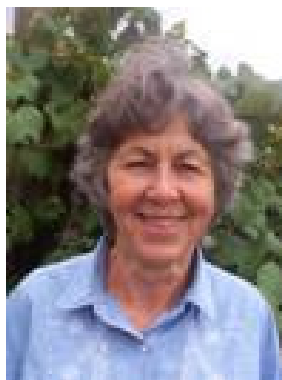
Sun 15 August:
